I、Project Background And Vision

II、Cooperation Directions And Recruitment Requirements

The Institute sincerely invites the following three types of strategic partners to join and seek common development:

1) Senior Intellectuals and Academic Experts in the Field of Traditional Chinese Medicine

Qualification Requirements*:

Have a doctoral degree in traditional Chinese medicine related majors or a professional title above deputy senior level, and possess rich clinical experience or scientific research achievements;

Have a deep understanding and recognition of traditional Chinese

medicine culture, and be willing to engage in the modern research and innovation of traditional Chinese medicine;

Have the ability of interdisciplinary cooperation, and those who are familiar with international medical standards and scientific research transformation processes will be given priority.

Cooperation Content:

Lead or participate in the core scientific research projects of the Institute (such as the development of classic famous prescriptions, integrated traditional Chinese and Western medicine treatment, etc.);

Serve as an academic advisor to promote the standardization and internationalization process of traditional Chinese medicine;

Jointly declare national scientific research projects and publish high-impact academic achievements.

2) Investors and Strategic Consortia in the Traditional Chinese Medicine Industry

-Qualification Requirements:

Domestic enterprises, consortia with investment experience in the traditional Chinese medicine industry, or business leaders who have long been concerned about the health care field;

Recognize the cultural value and market potential of traditional Chinese

medicine, and be willing to empower the scientific research and industrialization of traditional Chinese medicine with capital;

Have a global vision and can provide market channels, brand operation or policy resource support.

-Cooperation Content:

Jointly establish a traditional Chinese medicine technology transformation fund to support the research and development of innovative drugs and the implementation of achievements;

Jointly expand domestic and overseas markets (such as the export of traditional Chinese medicine preparations, health care and cultural tourism projects, etc.);

Participate in formulating the long-term strategic plan of the Institute and share the income from intellectual property rights.

3. Professional Talents in Chinese Herbal Medicine Planting and Processing

-Qualification Requirements*:

-Have more than 10 years of practical experience in the planting, harvesting, processing or quality inspection of Chinese herbal medicines;

-Be familiar with the origin resources of authentic medicinal materials, and master traditional processing techniques and modern standardized

production technologies;

-Be able to guide the establishment of GAP planting bases for Chinese medicinal materials or traceability management systems.

-Qualification Requirements:

Lead the construction of the Institute's medicinal material supply chain system to ensure the quality of raw materials and sustainable supply;

Develop demonstration bases for the cultivation of characteristic medicinal materials and inherit the intangible cultural heritage processing techniques;

Participate in formulating industry standards and promote the optimization and upgrading of the Chinese herbal medicine industry chain.

III. Cooperation Modes and Rights

1. Flexible Cooperation Forms:

Equity cooperation, technical equity participation, project joint venture or long-term strategic agreement, and customized solutions according to the needs of both parties.

2. Core Rights and Interests:

Share the benefits from the transformation of the Institute's scientific research achievements and the bonus of brand value appreciation;

Have priority to participate in the application of major national traditional

Chinese medicine projects;

Obtain the special policy support of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government for the traditional Chinese medicine industry.

1. Submit the Letter of Intent:

Provide personal or corporate qualification certificates, a brief introduction of past achievements and a cooperation plan (see the attachment for the template);

2. Preliminary Screening:

The expert committee of the Institute will evaluate the qualification and project fit.

3. In-depth Negotiation:

Conduct multiple rounds of consultations on the details of technical, financial or resource cooperation;

4. Signing and Implementation:

Sign a cooperation agreement and start the integration of resources and project implementation.
